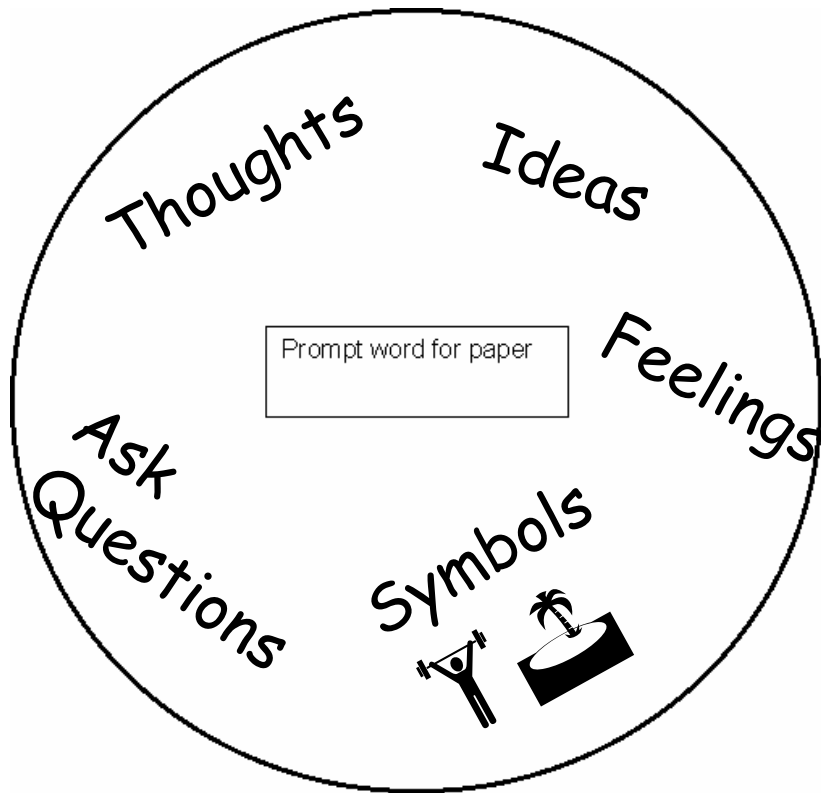


Clustering

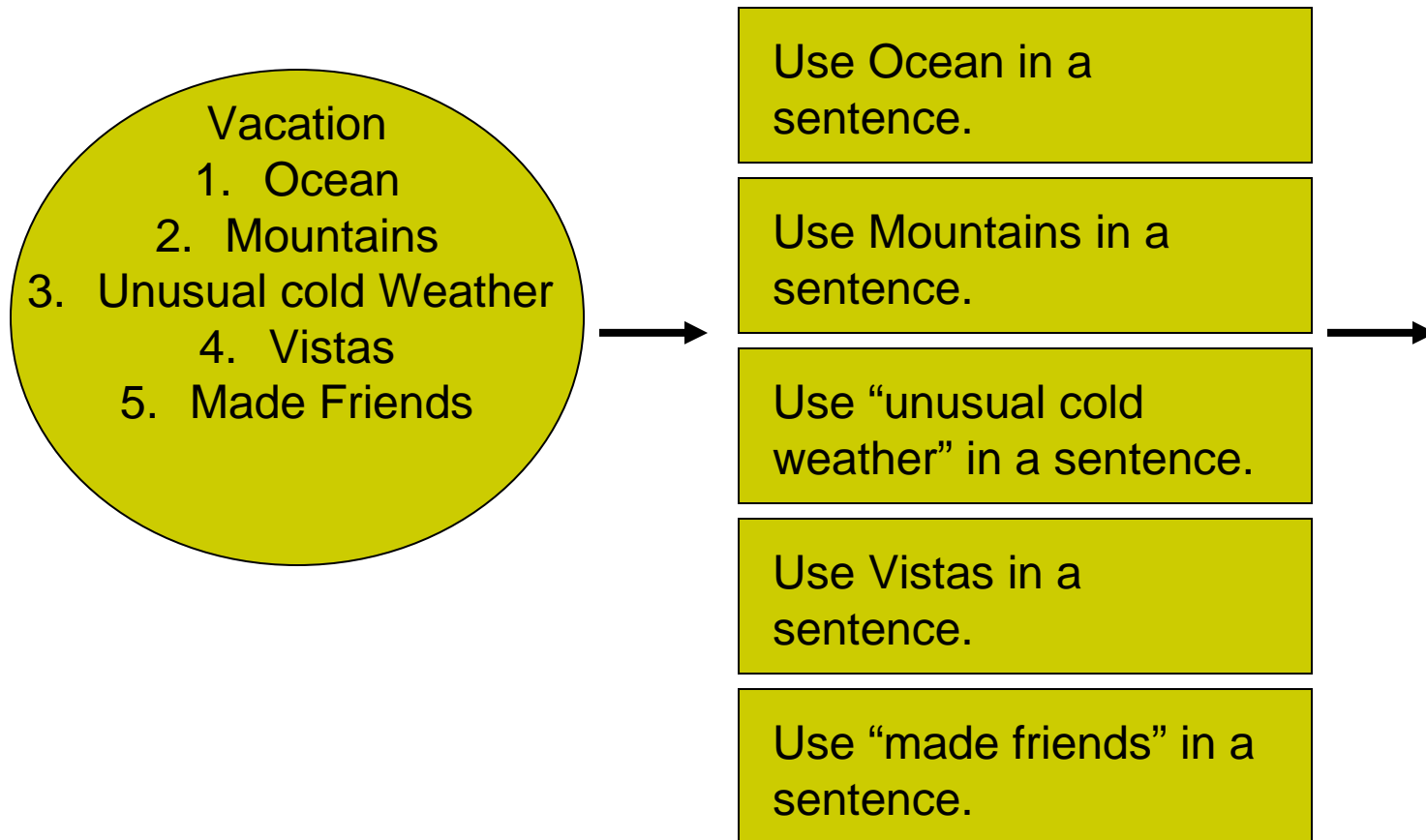


This process uses the creative brain first allowing the executive functioning part of the brain to organize writing later.

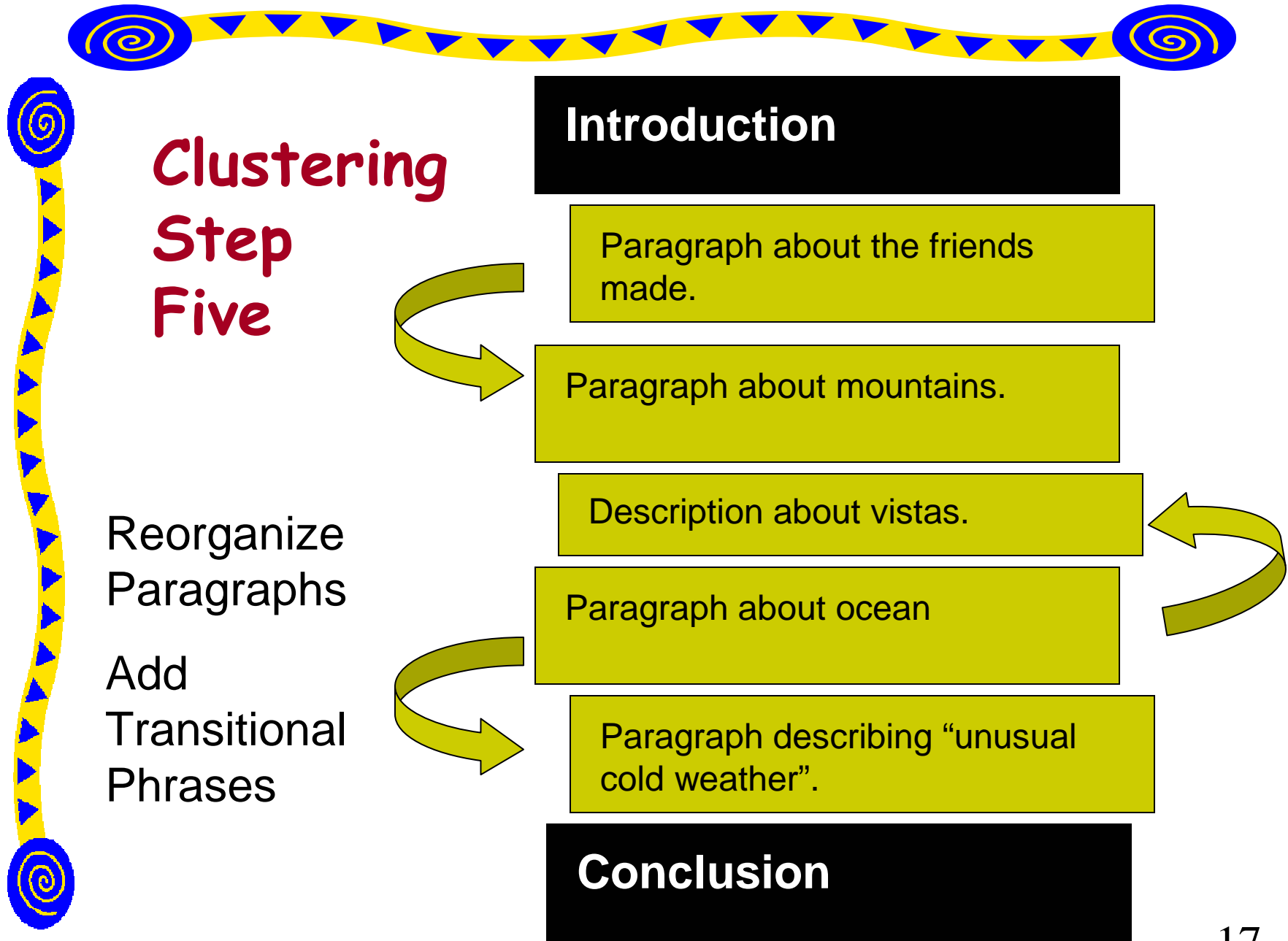
