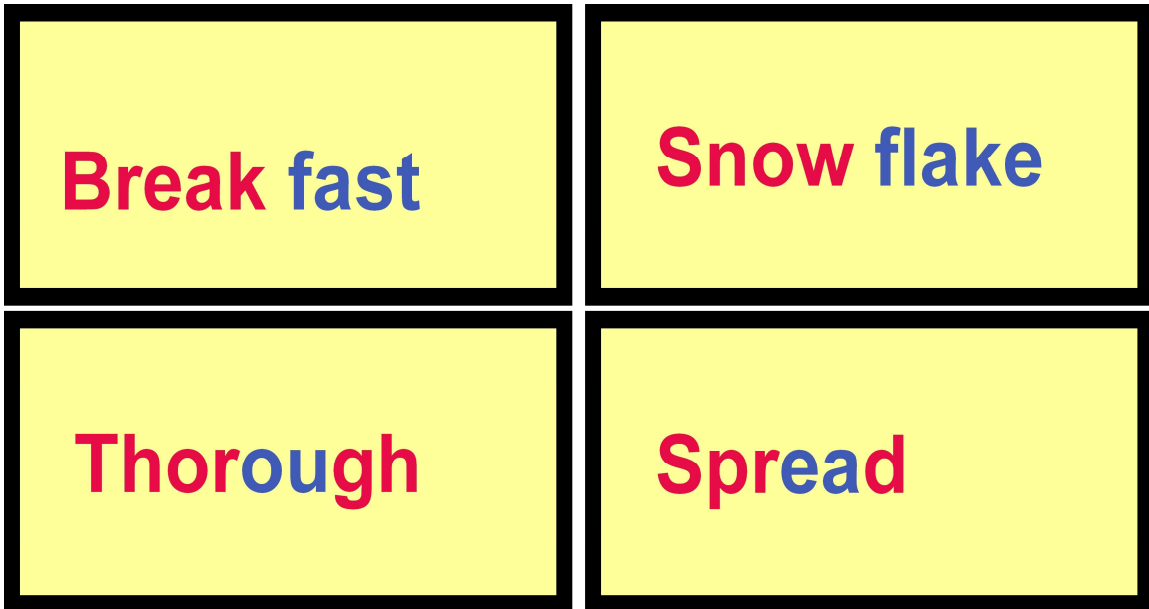
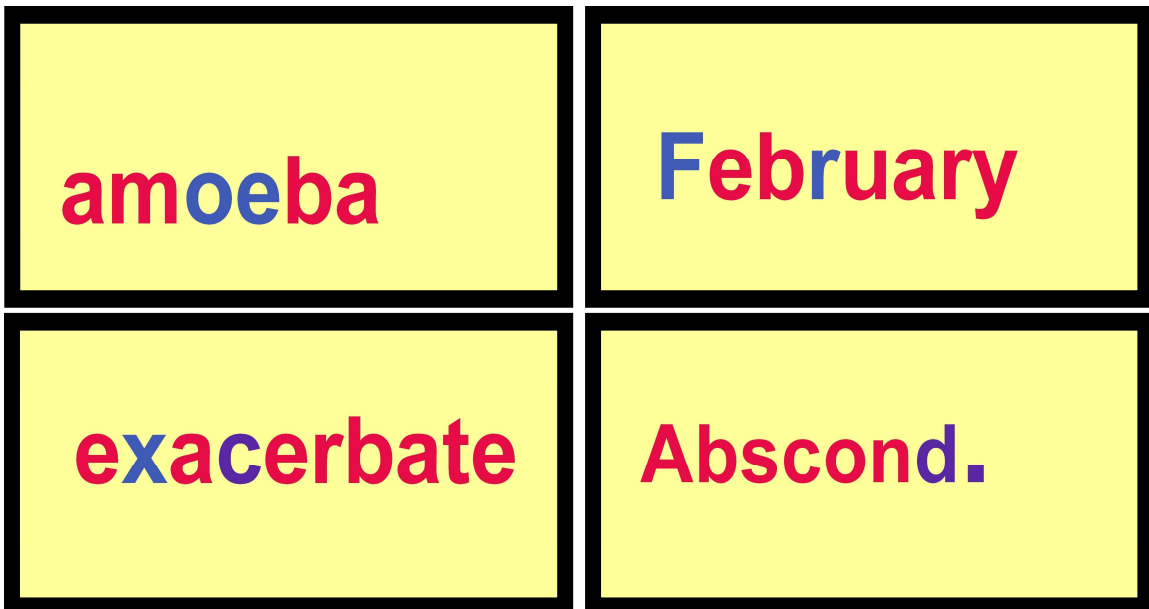


The Fitzpell Method of Studying Spelling & Vocabulary

Option 1: Use phonics rules to determine which letters should be in a stand-out color.



Option 2: Pretest. Use pre-test errors to determine which letters should be in a stand-out color.



- Whenever possible, add clip art pictures to 'visualize' the word.
- Use bright color markers with good contrast to differentiate.
- Add any other symbols, sound cues, etc. to make the spelling word more memorable.
- PRINT the words on INDEX CARDS.

Practice by running through the cards 2-3 times each day for the four days before the spelling test. Put aside the cards that need more study. Cards that can be spelled quickly can be pulled out of the daily 2nd and 3rd run.

Good luck! You should see a significant improvement in spelling test grades.
